

Energy Tax Incentives

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Common Taxes Imposed on Energy Producion



Severance Tax

LA tax imposed by a state on the extraction of non-renewables that is usually, but not always, for the consumption of other states.



Ad Valorem Tax

A tax bases on the assessed value of an item, such as real estate or personal property.



Impact Fee

A fee that state or local governments impose to recover costs associated with development.



Privilege/Franchise Tax

A tax that certain producers have to pay to concut business and operate in a state.



Types of Incentives



Abatement

A reduction or an exemption on the level of taxes.



Tax deduction

A deduction lowers the amount on an individual or entity's taxable income.



Tax credit

A credit is an amount that a taxpayer can subtract directly from the taxes they owe.




Rebate

A rebate is a sum of money that is credited or returned to a customer on completion of a transaction or activity.






States that provide biomass tax incentives.








Coal Tax Incentives
